

“Pick Up the Mic” Scholarship

The “Pick Up the Mic” scholarship has been established in 2005 for any senior at Albany High School who is interested in entering the field of communication, such as radio, television and newspapers. The idea and the funding for this scholarship have come from two local people who would like to encourage students to pursue such occupations in communications.

The applicant may attend a 2-year or a 4-year college. The minimum of 2.5 Cum GPA in high school is required. The recipient can be a male or a female who has declared a program major in some aspect of the communication field.

Selection will be conducted by a committee of local professionals in the communications field. Selection will be based on communications experience, involvement in school activities, and work experience.

This scholarship can be redeemed after the recipient has enrolled in and has finished one term of college. The recipient needs to provide a copy of his/her grade report to KASM Radio Station, Attn: Joe Gill or Randy Rothstein.

Return completed application to the Counseling Office at Albany High School by the designated deadline. The annual recipient will be revealed at the Senior Honors Banquet in May of each year.
